Under new rules, 50% pvt MBBS seats vacant

New Delhi: Deemed universities and private colleges across the country are staring at a huge crisis of unfilled undergraduate medical seats under the new system of centralised counselling introduced under Supreme Court's orders this year.

As the third round of counselling comes to an end on Thursday, more than 50% of MBBS seats and 84% of dental seats in these institutes are still lying vacant.

Majority of seats will remain unfilled, fear med colleges

These institutes fear that a majority of their seats will remain unfilled, as under the new rules, these universities will not be allowed to admit students on their own. Sources said, even in government colleges, nearly a third of the 15% seats under the all-India quota has remained unfilled till now. However, unlike deemed universities and private col-

leges, government institutions will get a chance to fill these seats as these will be transferred to the states.

A senior health ministry official said the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), which is conducting the counselling, will seek legal opinion on how to resolve the crisis of unfilled seats. What is troubling the deemed universities is the new matrix of counselling by DGHS.

KEA to conduct offline mop-up round

With several medical and dental seats going vacant, the Karnataka Examinations Authority has decided to conduct an offline mop-up round for allotment of these seats.

A majority of these seats are NRI quota seats. As many as 514 medical seats and 339 dental seats under the NRI quota are vacant.

These seats have no takers as they are expensive. Besides the NRI quota seats, the other seats that are vacant are all in minority medical colleges.

Counselling for allotment of these seats will be conducted between August 26 and 28.
