	<p>The program commenced with a welcome address by Dr. Suresh T. N., Professor of Pathology and Coordinator, MEU, SDUMC. The event was inaugurated by Dr. Prof. Prabhakar K., Dean, Faculty of Medicine and Principal, SDUMC, Kolar. In his inaugural address, he emphasized that Advancing Medical Education and Medical Curriculum Transition focuses on enhancing the quality of medical training to meet global standards and evolving healthcare needs. He highlighted the importance of competency-based learning, integration of technology, research orientation, and outcome-driven teaching methods. He further stated that the curriculum transition ensures that students are better equipped with clinical skills, critical thinking, and professionalism, enabling them to deliver patient-centred care in a rapidly evolving healthcare environment.</p> <p>Dr. Reem Zakaria, Ph.D., M.Sc., M.D., CPHQ, Medical Education Consultant, McGraw-Hill, delivered a session on “Advancing Medical Education and Medical Curriculum Transition.” She highlighted how medical education is evolving to meet the changing demands of healthcare systems and society. She discussed the differences in learning styles across generations, noting that Generation Z learners, as digital natives, prefer flexible, collaborative, and technology-supported learning environments.</p> <p>Dr. Reem emphasized the need for educators to adapt their teaching strategies to create more engaging and interactive learning experiences. She explained key trends in</p>

	<p>modern medical education such as competency-based learning, technology integration, and outcome-driven teaching methodologies that better prepare students for clinical practice. She also stressed the importance of transitioning from traditional content-heavy curricula to learner-centered approaches that promote critical thinking, problem-solving, and lifelong learning.</p> <p>She concluded by highlighting innovative strategies including simulation-based training, problem-based learning, and digital platforms, which play a vital role in preparing future healthcare professionals for the evolving healthcare landscape.</p> <p>Mr. P. Pradeep Kumar, Director – Sales India, McGraw-Hill Education, provided an overview of the digital resources published by the company.
